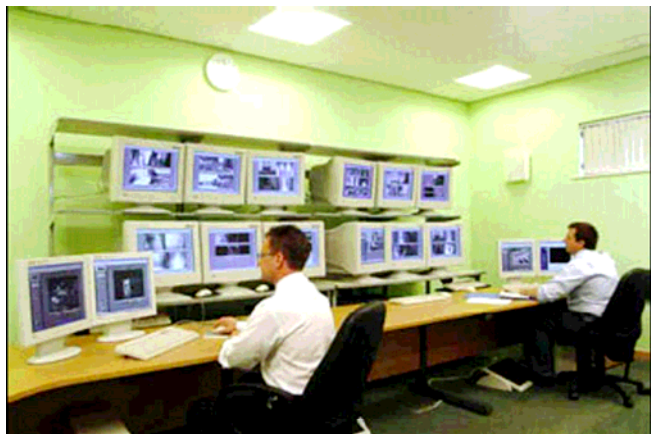


The first council monitored system in UK

Thurrock is one of the most industrially and economically developed areas in Britain with such companies as "Ford", "British Petroleum", "Shell" and "Procter & Gamble" operating there. Having to address the security issues in the most effective way, Thurrock Council Police was the first to use the leading edge technology for council monitored system in the UK on such a scale.

● **Benefits given by the distributed digital servers**

All 380 CCTV camera pictures feed back to a central monitoring center using the council's existing computer network. Two operator workstations handle the image monitoring, with two LCD screens per operator. The operators are able to note down the exact time of any event that need further investigation and see the images from the nearest camera to the incident. An "evidence" room at the control center is used by the police to print stills or to copy video recording onto CD or DVD. There is also a dedicated link to the police station to transmit incidents live for the police.

● **WebCCTV NVR value**

CCTV system offers close cooperation between the police and local authorities. Its value has been proved by deterring criminal activity, providing evidence to secure convictions and helping to reduce the fear of crime.
